## **Academic activities conducted during the session 2010-11 :**

1. Students' guidance center organized M.P.S.C. coaching classes. Some selected students on the basis of pre entrance test. 100 students were selected out of 150 students of various streams. Shyam Mandvewar of S.C.C. pariwar of Nagpur was the key resource person and Chief Instructor of the coaching classes and provided guidance in the subjects History, Geography, Constitution, Panchayat Raj etc. The classes were conducted for three months on every Wednesday and Thursday.

The workshop took place for 15 days (50 hours) in the month of October and November 2010. The college should not be disturbed by such activities, so the time schedule was kept on Saturday and Sunday from 9.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. The programme was very enthusiastically attended and benefited by 50 students. Squadron Leader Swati Mahajan of Indian Air Force conducted the workshop under Soft Skill Management Theme.

## **PART-B**

### **1. Activities reflecting goals and objectives of the Institution :**

The main objectives of the college is to impose quality education for the all round development of the students. The main emphasis is given on improving academic standard of the students through unit tests, seminars, coaching for competitive examinations, counseling the students for admission to P. G. To keep a disciplined atmosphere in the institution, a power point presentation by Superintendent of Police Mr. Suvez Haque was given. In the programme students and staff members from all over the district participated when Shri Haque elaborated the grave consequences of ragging and strict laws against it.

**Para Legal Training Camp :** The department of Law organized a Para Legal Training Camp for all the students inviting prime district Judge Shri Karanjkar and the whole bench of district.

**Voting Awareness Programme** : Under the district collector, Gondia Hon'ble Shri Zade, a programme on right to vote and inclusion of students in voter list was organized.

**Nirmal Gram Puraskar Survey** : The college worked in collaboration with Human Resource Ministry, Govt. of India under the scheme of Nirmal Gram Puraskar Survey. In this scheme 60 P.G. students of the college surveyed tirelessly to support the govt. scheme.
