It is like a mother institution of the colleges and schools of the GES. One of the main partners of C. J. Patel Company, Gondia Shri Harshadbhai Vora has generously donated the funds for the establishment of this college in the memory of his father Late Shri Natwarlal Maniklal Dalal. The college was further named as Natwarlal Maniklal Dalal College of Arts and Commerce by the G. E. S. This is not merely a college but it's a cherished creation of the founder Late Shri Manoharbhair Patel with a view to satisfy the educational needs of the masses. The great founder Late Shri Manoharbhair usually expressed that this college is a precious piece of his heart and he would like to develop it up to the highest level.

The foundation stone of this college was laid down by the father of Gondia Education Society Late Shri Manoharbhair Patel in the year 1958 and the building was inaugurated in the year 1961 by the then Chief Minister of Maharashtra Shri Dadasaheb Kannamwar. Application forms can be obtained from the college office. Application for admission must be accompanied by the following documents and formalities:

- a) The School or College Leaving Certificate in original.
- b) Mark Sheets of X & XII and last examination passed or failed together in original with two duly attested true copies of it.
- c) Migration Certificate in case of students, who are students of a University other than RTM Nagpur University or other than Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Education together with the migration fee of Rs. 200/- . A late fee of Rs. 100/- will be charged if the migration certificate is not submitted by the student before 15th August every year.
- d) Character Certificate.
- e) Students who have passed the examination shall submit School or College Leaving Certificate together with character certificates from two respectable citizens.
- f) An employee joining the College shall submit no objection certificate in original from his employer.
- g) Students are required to submit two copies of their photographs (Passport Size) along with their admission forms.
- h) Students should personally come for admission.

Note: *Incomplete application is liable to be rejected at any time.*

The applicant must fill student insurance form along with admission form mandatorily.

Facilities Available:

- (a) **Library :** We have a Central Library which houses reference and text books, journals, magazines, periodicals, novels encyclopedias on a wide variety of subjects.

The library also provides book bank facility to poor and needy students.

The library now boasts of INFLIBNET, E-journals, N-List & OPAC facilities which allow the students to search, locate and know the status of any book the students like to issue.

A Separate language laboratory is made available for the students of Communicative English and English Literature.

(d) Sports:

We at N.M.D. College have realized the importance of the overall development of the body and mind and consequently personality. We have well-equipped play ground, 16-stationed gym and all modern equipments.

(e) Auditorium and Seminar Hall:

We have ultra-modern auditorium equipped with 500 sitting capacity and seminar hall with 125 sitting arrangements.

ATTENDANCE

b) In order to qualify for appearing at the University Examination, every student must attend not less than **75 percent of the lectures** delivered in case of his subjects of study and satisfy the college authorities regarding his work progress and conduct.

c) Leave of absences will be given at the student's own risk and even a Medical Certificate or an Application of absence form the guardian will not entitle him for condonation of deficiency in the percentage of attendance in lectures required by University for the purpose of Examination.

d) A fine of `10/- for each lecture will be imposed on a student for absence from College. Students who desire to take leave must send in writing the application duly counter signed by their parents or guardian to the Principal well in time.

e) A fine of `20/- for each subject in one unit test will be imposed on a student for being absent in tests.

MEDICAL INSPECTION (Ordinance No. 84) :

Every student who remains absent from Medical Examination at the fixed date and time without sufficient cause, shall be liable to pay to the college a fine of `30/- or such sum as the college may fix for the course.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND RECREATIONAL :

1. All the undergraduate students of the college in all the faculties except Law shall be required to participate at their option in either of the following activities:
i) Physical Training OR ii) National Cadet Corps OR iii) National Service Scheme.
2. The College shall, as far as possible, arrange Social Service Camp for 10-15 days in "Diwali Vacation" under NSS in the nearby village for activities like:
a) Adult Education
b) Digging of Wells
c) Improvement of Roads
d) Imparting First Aid Knowledge to Villagers
e) Improvement of Sanitation
f) Other Village Upliftment Activities
g) "Shramdan" activities approved by the College.

STUDENTS AID FUND & TEXT BOOK LENDING LIBRARY:

The College has students Aid Fund Scheme viz. Text Book Lending Library. Under this scheme, needy and deserving students are provided a complete set of Text Books for use during the whole year on a nominal deposit. Books are to be returned in proper condition within a week after completion of the University Examination. The application for these books must be submitted before 31" July every year. An amount of `10/- as prescribed to be deposited along with the application. This amount will be refunded as soon as the books are returned to the office in good condition.

However the privilege to obtain books under this scheme is not a matter of right of the applicants.

CONDUCT RULES FOR STUDENTS :

- 1) All students shall observe the rules and discipline and are expected to have dignified behaviour and good character within the college and also in their social life.
2) Students are warned that they must not bring with them unauthorized persons in the college premises. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against the students who violate this rule.
3) Students must not wander about in the college premises when they have no classes. On no account they shall disturb the classes that are going on.
4) Students are warned against destroying college property defacing the college building or damaging furniture. Strict disciplinary action will be taken if this rule is violated.
5) Students are expected to obey all the orders and to teaching and non-teaching staff of the college.
6) Students are expected to be punctual and fully responsive in the class. Students shall not be allowed to join any other course of study simultaneously outside the college, full time or part time jobs/tution classes etc. clashing with college timing.
7) No Student shall attend classes other than his/her own. Off periods may be spent in Library/ Reading Room / Common Room. Students shall not unnecessarily loiter in the college premises or sit, stand in the corridors or sit on the parapet wall.
8) Writing, painting or Pasting Bills of any kind on walls, doors, windows, spitting or littering the college premises with any substance or committing any, un-hygenic act will entail a fine of `50/-
9) Student shall use the college furniture, fans, books or any other college property with utmost care. The cost of damage done shall be recovered from the students individually or collectively as the case may be.

COLLEGE LIBRARY:

The college has sufficient number of books in its library, The students are to observe the following instructions:
(i) The students are expected to keep the books issued to them in proper shape.
(ii) The books may be kept by students for not more than 15 days. A fine of `5/- per day for the delay will be imposed.

- 10) Students are not authorised to form unions or societies in the college. They shall not invite guests or arrange lecturers/programmes without prior permission of the Principal.
11) Any direct action on the part of the student like Morcha, Boycotting of classes, strike etc without prior intimation of at least 15 days to the Principal and without any just or legitimate cause or grievance will result in rustication of the concerned students.
12) Any change in the subject/subjects, facilities or medium will not be allowed unless permitted by the Principal.
13) Students shall be expected to keep their bicycles properly locked at the space provided in the college. No complaints regarding loss of cycles kept unlocked or not kept at the space provided shall be entertained.
14) Mobile phones are not allowed to operate in the college premises. Students found guilty of it shall be fined `50/- as per Govt. Order. -
15) Students of Degree level without college uniform shall not be allowed in the class room.

SCHOLARSHIPS / STIPENDS (General Instructions):

Govt, of India Post-Matric Scholarship to B. C. Students: The scheme of grant of Govt, of India, Scholarship to the backward Class Students / SC / ST / NT and OBC. Outside specified area in Vidharbha for post S.S.C, course is implemented by the Director of Social Welfare M. S. Pune. All the backward class students undertaking approved post S.S.C. Courses are considered eligible for the Govt, of India Scholarship with the following exceptions.

- Student can study competitive examination along with regular study
- Student can get 2 credit through the courses run by MJTSC
- Student can join certificate courses, diploma and advance diploma courses

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY:

- 1) The students switching over to another professional line after completing professional course in one, viz. LL.B. after B.T. /B.Ed. /B.E. after LL.B. will be eligible.
- 2) The students failing in the term / Annual examination are not considered eligible for the Scholarship. One failure is however condoned in respect of S.C. & S.T. Students pursuing medical and engineering courses.
- 3) Fresh Neo Budha students are not eligible to receive GOI, SCH, However their applications are considered under LIG, subject to the availability of funds.

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF FORM:

FOR G.O.I. SCHOLARSHIP:

All Backward class students and the students coming under the lower income group should apply for Govt, of India Scholarship in the prescribed form through their respective college in the month of June only. The application form will be available to them at the time of their admission. All the students should be vigilant enough to fill in the form complete in all respects as any omission or incorrect/false information may disqualify them for the above SCH. The students having gap in their education should invariably file a Court Affidavit declaring as to what they were doing during the intervening period. The students who were in receipt of Govt, of Indian Scholarship last year and have passed the Annual Examination are required to fill no application forms. Their cases will be submitted to the Director of Social Welfare by the college for renewal of scholarship. The students of B.A. Part-I, M.A. Part-I will be treated as FRESH CANDIDATES for purpose of scholarship and as such they are required to apply for scholarship in the prescribed form of the college.



FREE STUDENTSHIP EDUCATION CONCESSION:

- 1) Free-studentship to E.B .C. students
- 2) Free-studentship children of Primary Teachers
- 3) Free-studentship to B.C. students

E.B.C. CONCESSION:

- A) i) The students whose parents or guardians' (if parents are not alive) annual income of the previous year is less than ` 2,50,000/- are entitled for these concessions.
ii) Repeaters those who fail in the University Exam, and study in the same class are not entitled to E. B .C. iii) E.B.C. will not be granted on Basic Pay only to the Private and Central Govt. Employees' wards.
iv) Students who have once taken their Post Graduate Degree are not entitled to E.B.C. If they get themselves admitted either for another Post Graduate Degree of Law.
v) The students should take note of the. fact that if their Parents/Guardians are Private/Central Govt. Employees, their entitlement of concession depends upon the total salary i.e. basic as well as other allowance that is to say to the total salary should be less than ` 2,50,000/-
- B) Students whose ordinary place of residence is within the state of Maharashtra only are entitled to free studentship. Students belonging to other states are not eligible for the grant of free studentship.
- C) A student who has failed in one class in a faculty and changed the course of study and joined another faculty cannot be granted E.B.C. concession as he repeats in the same standard.
- D) Application for E.B.C. concession must be accompanied with Income Certificate of the previous year's income irrespective of the rural or urban area to which the student belongs. The income certificate must be signed by any the following persons especially:
i) Gazetted Officer of any department
ii) Revenue non-ministerial office not below class III status. Income Certificate signed by persons other than those mentioned above shall not be accepted.
- E) Application form must be submitted with Income Certificate in duplicate.
- F) A student is entitled to enjoy the educational concession under one scheme only at a time.
- G) A student enjoying E.B.C concession must fulfil at least 75% of the attendance and must behave in disciplined way failing which his free studentship shall be discontinued and permission to appear at the Examination may not be granted to him.
- H) In case of applicant's parent or guardian is illiterate, he should put his left hand thumb impression with the following words below left hand thumb impression of (Name of Parent).

Note: Student will be informed separately regarding E.B.C., G.O.I. & other types of scholarships from time to time and will be guided for the submission of forms.

RULES FOR FREE STUDENTSHIP OF PRIMARY SCHOOL TEACHERS:

Children of all full time Primary School Teachers working in
i) Government



- ii) Local bodies schools and
- iii) Recognised and aided private primary school are eligible for concession of free studentship condition of eligibility.
- a) Free studentship shall be subject to regular attendance (not less than 75%) satisfactory progress and good conduct.
- b) At the post S.S.C / H.S.S.C state the pupil's progress should be regarded as satisfactory for the purpose of continuance of the concession if he has secured a minimum of 45% marks of the aggregate.
- c) Free studentship shall be awarded only to the pupil whose parents are residents in M.S.
- d) Application shall be made within a period of 30 days from date of the opening of the Educational Institution in the case of pupil who has been already admitted and within a period of 30 days from the date of admission in case of pupil newly admitted.
